INTERNATIONAL FLUTE COMPETITION - IX EDITION ONLINE CAT.A,B and ELIMINATION PHASE CAT.C,D,E on JUNE 29TH FINAL PHASE IN PERSON CAT.C,D,E - VENICE on SEPTEMBER 14TH

The competition was created with the aim of promoting and spreading musical culture, encouraging exchange and comparison between young musicians, enhancing their talents.

COMPETITION RULES.

1. The competition is open to flutists of different levels and of any nationality.

2. You can participate either as a soloist or as a member of a chamber or ensemble group. In this case, two forms must be filled out for each request to participate and the relevant fees must be paid.

3. Participants may register for a category higher than that required for their age, but not for a lower one.

4. To participate, the fee for the various categories (A,B,C,D,E) must be paid as reported in the announcement.

Registrations must be made by June 15 2025, by filling out the appropriate form which can be downloaded from the website www.scuoladimusicagiuseppeverdi.it news section. The registration form must be sent by email to: concorsoatuttoflauto@gmail.com together with a copy of the bank transfer and a copy of a valid identity document.

The candidate must communicate the link where they can view the video of the recording of their performance which will be uploaded to their YouTube channel as a private video, available only to the competition jury.

5. IMPORTANT RULE: Each video must include the name of the person performing before recording the song. It must be made by taking a full-length shot of the candidate in which the hands must be visible, a sign must be displayed with the words: "INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION A TUTTO FLAUTO 2025" and it must be made in a single sequence without interruption. Anyone who violates this rule will be disqualified.

8. DETAILS AND INFORMATION

9. PROGRAMS

FLUTE SOLOISTS SECTION

Category A, B, C, : free choice program

<u>Category D:</u> The performance program for the preliminary phase includes a compulsory piece chosen from the following:

-J.S BACH - Partita in A min. for flute solo "Allemanda";

-C. PH. E. BACH, sonata in A minor for flute solo, 1° mov.

-G.P.TELEMANN- 12 Fantasies, one of the following: nos. 2.6

-W.A.MOZART, Concerto in G Major K313 (1°mov. Allegro maestoso)

-F. POULENC, Sonata for flute and piano (1° mov. Allegretto melancholic)

-C.REINECKE, Ballade, Op.288

<u>Category E</u> :The performance program for the preliminary phase includes a compulsory piece chosen from the following:

- -J.IBERT. , Piece
- -E.VARESE, Density 21.5
- -S. KARG-ELERT, Sonata Appassionata
- -L. BERIO, Sequence I
- -W.A.MOZART, Concerto in G Major K313 (1st mov. Allegro maestoso)
- -A.CASELLA, Siciliana and Burlesca Op. 23
- -F.MARTIN, Ballade for flute and piano
- -C.NIELSEN, Concerto for flute and orchestra, (1st mov.)

Final test cat. D and E: a piece of free choice lasting max. 20 minutes: one Sonata for flute and piano or two movements from a Concert for flute.

The winners of other international competitions will have the right to directly access the final phase of the competition.

ACCOMPANYING PIANIST FOR FINAL PHASE: competitors may come with a pianist of their choice or use the competition's accompanying pianist by sending a copy of the score they intend to perform and adding 25 euros to the registration fee.

CHAMBER MUSIC SECTION

Free choice programme, max. 15 minutes. Chamber music category is online.

10. PRIZES

Certificate of partecipation for everyone.

SCHOTT and INTERNATIONAL MUSIC EDITIONS prize: gift scores for the first overall prize in the cat.A and B and CHAMBER MUSIC.

SUONO prize: 50 euro voucher to spend at the SUONO store in Padua for the first overall prize in the cat. C.

BALINT prize: Scholarship of 100 euros and reimbursement of the registration fee for the first overall prize in the cat. D.

Award Concert at Piccola Orchestra Barocca in Ponte di Piave for the winners of the A and B categories.

Award concert at Castelfranco Veneto Conservatory "A.Stefani" or in Venice for the winners of C, D and E categories.

11. EVALUATION CRITERIA

First overall in the category to the candidate who has received a score between 99 and 100/100; 1st Prize to the candidate or candidates who have achieved a score between 95 and 98/100; 2nd Prize to the candidate(s) who have achieved a score between 90 and 94/100; 3rd Prize to the candidate(s) who have achieved a score between 85 and 89/100. Below the third prize, no scores will be assigned but a certificate of participation will be issued.

12. By registering for the competition they also sign a release for the free use of their images and recordings by the organizers. For minors, authorization is granted by a parent or guardian.

13. For the "D, E" category, the winners of other international competitions will have the right to directly access the final phase of the competition, which includes a piece of their choice for flute and piano.

14. The commission will listen to the program presented by the candidates as long as it does not exceed the time limits set in the REGULATION;

The competitors, in turn, have the right to perform pieces of shorter duration than the maximum time indicated by the tests for each category.

15. An email will be sent by the management confirming correct receipt of registration. The management will communicate to each competitor his result in the competition

16. The commission may decide to award any prizes on equal merit. The decisions of the commissions are final and unappealable.

17. Each competitor will be issued a certificate of participation.

18. Failure to participate in the competition will not give the right to any refund.

19. Participation in the competition entails unconditional acceptance of these rules without any reservations.
